## THE RUSSELL D. ANDERSON/WILBUR SNYPP AWARD

There have been 47 recipients of the award, which was renamed in April of 2021 following the passing of legendary publicist and longtime National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) treasurer and associate executive director Russell D. Anderson.

The prestigious award has been presented annually by the NCBWA since 1975 when in 1962 NCBWA founder Wilbur (Bill) Snypf of Ohio State earned the honor. Snypf captured the inaugural award in '75, while Anderson was honored in 2002.

The Russell D. Anderson/Wilbur Snypf Award honors a professional yearly for his/her contributions to the sport of collegiate baseball. Voting is done by a panel of previous winners, who include past NCAA World Series directors, College Sports Information Directors of America Hall of Fame members, decorated media members and many others.
