- 2. Recipient must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester in college
- 3. To continue to receive the \$1,000 scholarship annually, the recipient must inform the USBWA in writing by July 1 each year that he or she is enrolled in college as a full-time student for the following fall semester.
- 4. Applicants may submit a maximum of three recommendations
