

USBWA NATIONAL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK (Jan. 10, 2017)

MEN: WILL VORHEES, Notre Dame College (Mountain East Conference), 6-8, Jr., F, Columbus Grove, Ohio

Will Vorhees has been selected the U.S. Basketball Writers Association Division II Men's Basketball Player of the Week after the 6-foot-8, 240-pound forward went for 30 points in all three of Notre Dame College's victories last week, helping the Falcons improve to 11-2 overall, 5-2 in Mountain East Conference play.

Vorhees averaged 35.0 points, 9.7 rebounds, and 3.3 assists on the week while shooting 62 percent (41-for-66) from the floor, including a 50 percent (6-for-12) clip from three-point range. He opened the three-game week with a 44-point, 10-rebound effort in a 97-93 win over Glenville State, and two days later notched another double-double with 30 points and 10 rebounds in Notre Dame's 79-65 victory over West Virginia Wesleyan. He finished the week one rebound shy of a third double-double as he notched 31 points, nine rebounds, and four assists in the Falcons' 95-87 road win over Concord.

WOMEN: MIKI GLENN, California University of Pennsylvania (Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference), 5-7, Sr., G, Bridgeport, W.Va.

Miki Glenn of California University of Pennsylvania was named the U.S. Basketball Writers Association Women's Division II National Player of the Week for the week ending January 8.

Glenn, a 5-7 senior guard, was chosen the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) West Athlete of the Week for the third time this season after scoring more than 60 points in two road victories last week, averaging 30.5 points, 8.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game.

Glenn scored 29 points on 11-of-18 shooting last Tuesday in an 87-56 win at Gannon, while also tallying nine assists, three rebounds, two steals and one block.

The West Virginia native then set a season-high with 32 points on 11-of-18 shooting, including four-of-six from beyond the arc, in a 107-73 victory at West Chester on Friday. Glenn also tallied eight assists, three rebounds, three steals and one block against the Golden Rams.

She finished the week shooting 61.1 percent from the floor, including 53.8 percent (7-of-13) from beyond the arc, and converted all 10 free-throw attempts.

The reigning PSAC West Athlete of the Year, Glenn leads the league in scoring at 19.1 points per game and also paces the conference with 7.3 assists and 3.1 steals per game. She also enters the week leading NCAA Division II in assists per game and has helped the Vulcans to a 14-1 overall record, including an 8-1 mark in the PSAC.
